SCRIPTURE -- Old Testament Jeremiah 4: 1-11, 18

If you return, O Israel, says the LORD, if you return to me, if you remove your abominations from my presence, and do not waver, ² and if you swear, "As the LORD lives!" in truth, in justice, and in uprightness, then nations shall be blessed^{III} by him, and by him they shall boast. ³ For thus says the LORD to the people of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem: Break up your fallow ground, and do not sow among thorns. ⁴ Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, remove the foreskin of your hearts, O people of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, or else my wrath will go forth like fire, and burn with no one to quench it, because of the evil of your doings. ⁵ Declare in Judah, and proclaim in Jerusalem, and say: Blow the trumpet through the land; shout aloud^{III} and say, "Gather together, and let us go into the fortified cities!" ⁶ Raise a standard toward Zion, flee for safety, do not delay, for I am bringing evil from the north, and a great destruction. ⁷ A lion has gone up from its thicket, a destroyer of nations has set out; he has gone out from his place to make your land a waste; your cities will be ruins without inhabitant. ⁸ Because of this put on sackcloth, lament and wail: "The fierce anger of the LORD has not turned away from us." ⁹ On that day, says the LORD, courage shall fail the king and the officials; the priests shall be appalled and the prophets astounded. ¹⁰ Then I said, "Ah, Lord GOD, how utterly you have deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying, 'It shall be well with you,' even while the sword is at the throat!" ¹¹ At that time it will be said to this people and to Jerusalem: A hot wind comes from me out of the bare heights^[4] in the desert toward my poor people, not to winnow or cleanse—¹⁸ Your ways and your doings have brought this upon you. This is your doom; how bitter it is! It has reached your very heart."

SCRIPTURE -- New Testament Luke 15: 1-10

15 Now all the tax collectors and sinners were coming near to listen to him. ² And the Pharisees and the scribes were grumbling and saying, "This fellow welcomes sinners and eats with them." ³ So he told them this parable: ⁴ "Which one of you, having a hundred sheep and losing one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness and go after the one that is lost until he finds it? ⁵ When he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders and rejoices. ⁶ And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost.' ⁷ Just so, I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. ⁸ "Or what woman having ten silver coins, if she loses one of them, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? ⁹ When she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.' ¹⁰ Just so, I tell you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
