Dixieland Devotional - Our Dixieland Devotional series for this year was completed with a great performance on May 19th. The free will offering collected during the three performances totaled \$2,224, which will be shared equally by Peaches Pantry, NAMI, and the Sierra Vista Community Band. Thank you for your support!

Pentecost Special Offering - Pentecost, the celebration of the birthday of the Church, will be observed, this year, on June 5th. Traditionally, the Pentecost special offering is donated to an organization or project which supports youth activities. This year the Presbyterian Church (USA) recommends that 40% of the special offering stay with our congregation, 25% go to support Young Adult Volunteers (YAV), 25% go to support Ministries with youth, and 10% will be devoted to children at risk. Your Mission and Stewardship Committee supports this distribution. We recommend that Faith's 40% be donated to Montlure and the 13.2 Organization, which helps youth who are graduating from foster care. A foundation of faith established during childhood through young adulthood helps ensure lifelong faith and service. If you choose to give by check, please ensure that you note "Pentecost Offering" on the memo line. You may also donate on the Faith website at www.faithpresb.org and click on "Donate Now" at the top right of the page and select Pentecost and enter the donation amount.
