Dear beloved Faith family,

We are so grateful to receive your cards with their lovely and thoughtful words, and thank you so much for thinking of us and praying for us. We miss you all very much!

We have been here over five months now, and we really enjoy the environment and serving the church and the community. It's so beautiful with green trees, grass, and cornfields.

Gary and I are doing well here. Gary has a job, driving for Nebraska transit from Fullerton to other cities and towns in this eastern part of the state Monday through Friday. It's operated by a non-profit organization, and it is mostly people going to medical appointments. He said he likes doing it.

I am still busy with my ministry though my time is more manageable than before. I have officiated five funeral services since I came to Fullerton. It has been emotionally challenging, but it has also been an honor and privilege and a blessing to know the people and families here.

New Pastor Search Update

The Pastor Nominating Committee (Scott Bird, Sandy) Brown, Richard Carter, Carolyn Malik, Gene Raymond, Fred Whitley, and Pam Winters) has now been at work for one year. We have met over thirty times, usually weekly or every other week. We have reviewed and This Photo by Unknown



evaluated 163 Personal Information Forms (PIFs) of pastors seek a new call. Part of this evaluations involves watching on-line sermons on YouTube or other media. Each PNC member has reviewed about 40 or 50 sermons of the most likely candidates online. Based on these reviews, we have sent thirty-eight follow-on requests for information to prospective candidates. The responses we received to these requests led us to conduct eleven zoom interviews so far.

During this past year we have come close to identifying a possible new installed pastor several times, but God has had a different plan. It is always difficult when God's answer to prayer is "wait." The Committee asks the Congregation to continue to keep us in their prayers as we continue the search for Faith's new installed pastor. We also want to thank the Congregation for your past support and prayers and patience.
