The biggest event we have in August is "The Big Event," which is put on by our presbytery, Presbytery de Cristo. Like last year, we will serve as a hub for other Presbyterian churches in the county in addition to a host of people from our congregation. The theme of the event this year is "Eradicating Systemic Poverty." The keynote speaker for the all-day event is the Rev. Dr. Bill Brown from Columbia Theological Seminary in Decatur, Ga. I invite you all to attend and learn more about what we can do to fight poverty and economic hardship both locally and elsewhere. Also, if you can help with setting up Stevenson Hall, serving food and refreshments, and greeting people, please sign up in the narthex or call me or Office Manager Judy Mayhew. This month marks the return of the backpack program, where we assemble backpacks with essential goods and toiletries for homeless residents. We will be packing more than 70 backpacks, so toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, and other items are needed. There will be a black tote box in the narthex to place your donated items. Thank you for your generosity! This is a great mission effort in the community and brings some comfort to those who need a helping hand.

I received some good feedback for the mini-sermon series on women in the Bible, and I plan on bringing that back periodically. On Aug. 27, I am bringing back "Stump the Pastor" instead of the usual sermon that day. I hope it is engaging and educational and that I don't embarrass myself too much.

Thank you to everyone who made the dedication and celebration in honor of Rev. Virginia Studer a success on July 22. I am grateful that so many of you came out to have the chance to celebrate Rev.
