Toys are being accepted for "Child and Family Resources" from December 3 through December 14


Baby toys from newborn to age 5 are very much in need!



Pastor Brian is leading the group.






Treasurer's Update By Gene Raymond Faith Treasurer

END OF YEAR STATUS. We are now in the "home stretch" for the Church Fiscal Year. I thought it would be a good idea to let the congregation know how we are doing as we near the end. The chart below shows our income and expenses with respect to this year's estimated budget through mid-November. The blue line is the budget, the red line is expenses (of course) and the green is income. As you can see, we are below the budget line for both income and expenditure, this is actually pretty common for us, at least during the 23+ years I have been a member of Faith. What is important is that due to careful stewardship by the Session and your generous giving our income has kept pace with our expenses. So, keep up the good work! As we begin the season of the Advent of the one who is the very Incarnation of sacrificial giving it would be a good time if you *are* a little behind in your giving for you to catch up or even "go the extra mile."



ANNUAL STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN STATUS. Thank you to everyone who renewed or increased their pledge to support Faith's ministries for next year. As of November 20th, we received total pledges (including per capita and advanced giving) of \$ 175,754. This is about 56%

of what we need for next year's ministries. So please continue to prayerfully consider your pledge for next year. Please also consider paying the Per Capita as a separate payment (this year the per capita is \$42 for each individual of your family who is a member of Faith). The Per Capita funds the denomination's work (e.g., General Assembly, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, and Presbyterian Mission Agency), the Synod's, and the Presbytery's (such as *Frontera de Cristo*, Middle Eastern Presbyterian Fellowship, Montlure



Camp, Presbyterian Campus Ministry, and Tucson Borderlands Young Adult Volunteers). If you have already turned in your pledge card without the Per Capita that's OK; just donate the correct amount when you actually pay your Per Capita pledge. It will make our regular budget go farther!
