



#### TREASURER'S UPDATE

ANNUAL STEWARDSHIP CAMPAIGN STATUS. Thank you to everyone who

renewed or increased their pledge so far to support Faith's ministries for next year. We have totaled the pledges received on Pledge Sunday and earlier and they total over \$200,000! Last year about this time we had only received \$188,500. SO, KEEP UP THE GOOD WORK! You can submit a pledge card at any time if you haven't already.



The recent financial gifts we have received have given Faith a new financial freedom to think about what other ways we can serve Christ. The budget this year will still have to deal with salaries, utilities, regular maintenance, and some long-delayed facility improvements, including much-needed improvements to our audio-visual capabilities. However, we also have a new freedom to increase outreach and community ministries that we have had to draw back on recently. If you are still considering your pledge, I ask you to think about what Faith and its mission means to you. Think about the testimonies of the members you heard recently and what Faith has meant to them. Think about the things your pledges have accomplished in the past in the nursing homes and for the homeless in Sierra Vista, and for those in need in the Solomon Islands and across the border in Mexico. Your pledge, whatever the amount, will be used to advance the ministries to which God has called us.

Please also consider paying the Per Capita as a separate payment (this year the per capita is \$44 for each individual of your family who is a member of Faith). The Per Capita funds the denomination's work (e.g., General Assembly, Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, and Presbyterian Mission Agency), the Synod's, and the Presbytery's. We have to pay Per Capita anyway, so if you donate it up front, it will make our regular budget go farther!



#### RECYCLING PROGRAM
