Dear Faith Members and Friends,

Thank you for everyone's hard work in getting the church set up for all the Holy Week services and Easter Sunday! It was great to have so many people in the sanctuary for these holy days. The music, the participation of the congregation, it all made the services moving and memorable. Thank you and Praise God!

We have many special events coming up this month, so we are going to need your help in pulling them off!

First, get ready for a bluegrass-gospel show on **Thursday**, **May 1**, at 6 pm in the sanctuary when **Bluegrass From Heaven** will be performing! This is the first of the three-part **Faith Trinity Concert Series** this spring that will benefit local Sierra Vista charities. A freewill offering will be gathered during the show, much like was done in the past for the Dixieland Devotionals. The total of the goodwill offerings designated for the charities for the three concerts will be split among three charities. The Mission and Stewardship committee has voted this year to give the money raised to the local Salvation Army, Peach's Pantry, and the Volunteer Interfaith Caregiver Program (VICaP).



QUARTERLY UPDATE. It is probably time to let everyone know how we are doing Financially at Faith. The graph below shows our Income versus Expenses for the first quarter of this year. It is a little hard to tell the difference between the lines, which is a *good thing*! It means our income, expenses, and our budget projection are all in line with each other. The good income situation is due to your, the Family of Faith's generosity, through pledges and gifts and the good expenses situation is due to the



diligent financial stewardship of the Session and its committees. Keep up the good work everyone! A sound financial foundation makes it easier to do Jesus's work in the world.


A LITTLE CHANGE TO THE BUDGET. At the April Session meeting, the Session voted unanimously to increase the budget by a "whopping" \$887. The total budget estimate for 2025 is now \$294,065. The only reason this small change is worth mentioning is that the Session did this to allow us to pay for the training of a new Stephen Ministry Leader. This increase will cover the cost of the online classes and materials. We have not had a trained Stephen Ministry Leader since Mary Davis joined the Saints Triumphant. A trained Stephen Ministry Leader is necessary to provide training for new Stephen Ministers and continuing education and guidance for our existing Stephen Ministers. It is not often that a spending increase is a reason for celebration, but this one is!








~ Farewell to Chuck and Jim! ~


